- Lead the day to day relationship with the GFSC, FCA, GFIU, GRA, and other relevant bodies.
- Act as part of the Group Risk leadership team and provide appropriate AICL input into HGH matters.
- Ensure that Advantage corporate governance, controls and compliance procedures meet regulatory requirements.
- Lead the resolution of critical and important risk management and compliance issues.
- Lead an agreed programme of risk management and compliance assurance 2nd line assessments including collaboration with Group Assurance and Internal Audit.
- Provide 2nd line challenge & review of the Conduct & Outsourcing framework and activities
  of that function.
- Ensure company policies are adequate and appropriate as well as proportionate.
